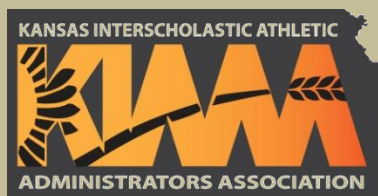

<b>Total</b>	<b>29</b>	<b>78.38%</b>	<b>8</b>	<b>21.62%</b>





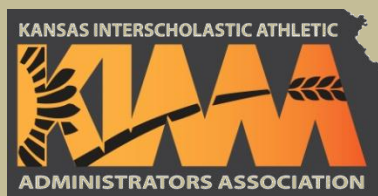
